Aristotle University of Thessaloniki organizes a summer school at the summer camp of Kalandra, Halkidiki, Greece, a beautiful and secure place next to the sea, which offers a warm and welcoming environment and a unique experience of nature and culture, as it is situated near Thessaloniki and the archaeological sites of Dion, Vergina and Mount Athos. The two-week course, from July 30 to August 12, 2014, is designed for participants from all backgrounds, those who are already well-read in and those who are just starting out, with the purpose of getting them acquainted with studies in the fields of Greek Philosophy, Greek History and Archaeology, Ancient Drama, Ancient Technology, Architecture and Ecology, Astronomy and Mythology. The lively exchanges of views and the summer camp experience make this brief, intense period of study, an extraordinarily and enriching experience. Each weekday will consist of five hours of teaching in the morning, by distinguished speakers, largely from within the University, followed by general lectures as well as cultural activities and a Greek language course (1h.30/day) in the afternoon. Also, there will be organized tourist and cultural visits to the beautiful beaches of Halkidiki and places of cultural interest, such as Dion, Vergina and Mount Athos, all of which are designed to make participants familiar with Greek Culture and History.

#### THE ACADEMIC COURSE:

#### ANCIENT GREEK PHILOSOPHY, ARCHAEOLOGY, ARTS AND TECHNOLOGY

1. Greek Philosophy
2. Greek History and Archaeology
3. Ancient Drama
4. Ancient Technology, Architecture and Ecology
5. Astronomy and Mythology

Greek Language teaching: 1h.30/day

#### LECTURES

Daily lectures by distinguished speakers, largely from within the University. For 12 days, participants will follow 5 hours of lectures daily from Monday to Friday. A certificate of attendance will be awarded to all participants who complete successfully the course.

#### EVENING LECTURES - PARALLEL ACTIVITIES

Additional general lectures as well as cultural activities will add to your enjoyment of your stay.

Apart from the lectures, there will be parallel activities that any participant could choose to attend, such as team building-bonding activities and exercises, themed cultural evenings, movie nights etc.

#### COMMENTS

Teaching is in English.

#### WHO SHOULD APPLY?

Students who have completed at least one year at an institute of higher education, young scientists and academic staff.
